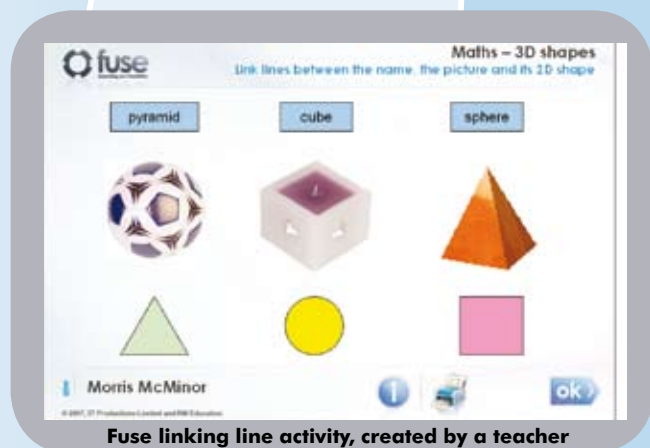
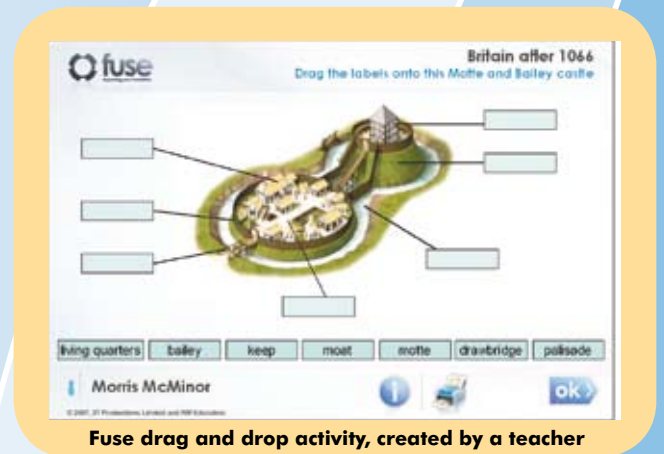
Export activities for use on standalone computers, on web sites, in your VLE or even on your miniBook computer.

The content creation process



1

Create pages of content using your own images and text, based on interactive page templates. Pages can include 'scored' activities, which are automatically marked.

2

Having created pages, define progression between them using the highly visual sequencing tool. Sequences can be linear, or can include branching, based on user selection or scores.

3

Add an optional final report page and feedback messages for users. Activity reports can usefully inform assessment for learning.

4

Try out and edit the activity.

5

Export the activity and make it available to students via a web page, by sharing it on your school network, intranet, or by importing it into your VLE or Learning Space.

Page styles that can be generated by Fuse Creator:

- Drag and drop
- Linking lines
- Multiple choice
- User Choice (menu page)
- Information page
- Ordering
- Cloze (fill the gaps)
- Report page

Fuse pages can include users' own photos, images and sound files. These can be designed for use within any curriculum area and by any age group.

Fuse content can be built as linear or non-linear sequences, allowing for personalisation and differentiation.
