## 1. 'Governor' and 'Other' accounts

This month's release brings the ability to add 'Governor' and 'Other' roles to RM Unify, hence enabling key School stakeholders to enjoy the benefits of RM Unify.

RM Unify Administrators can create these users via CSV upload, accessed via the **Management Console**. It's simple to do, just include the relevant role in to the **Role Column** when creating and uploading a CSV.

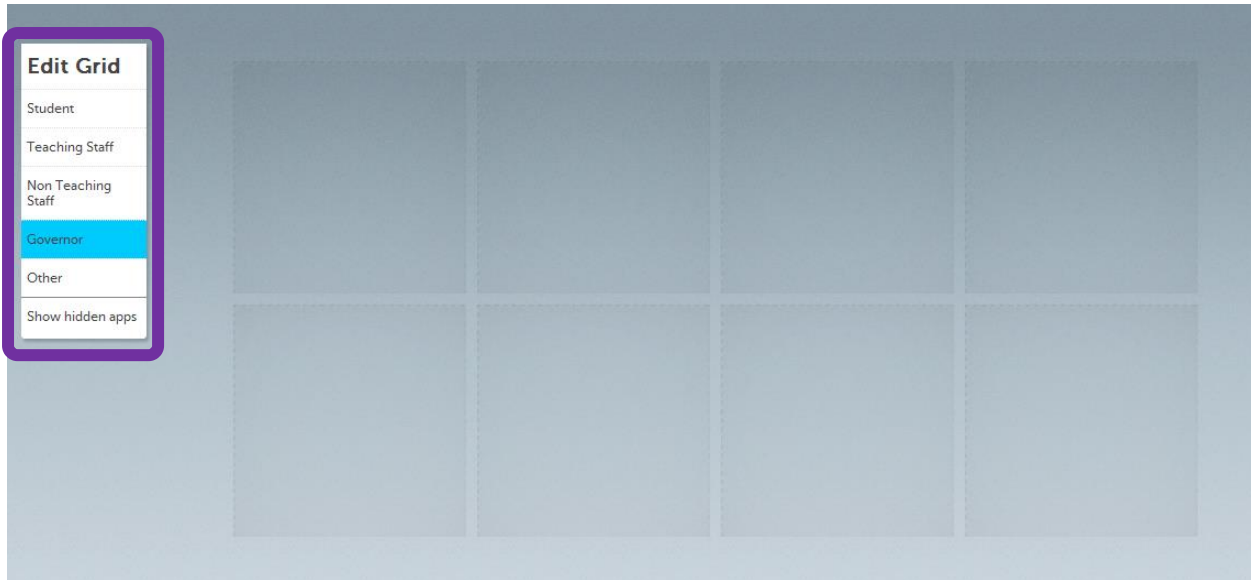

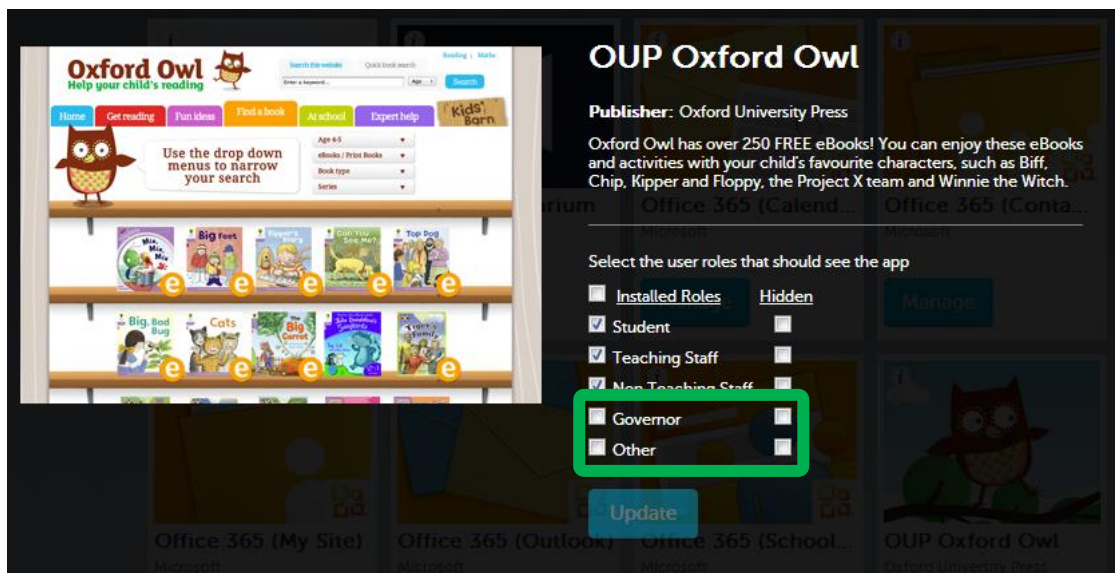


This means you are now ready to distribute the sign in details you included in the CSV. The 'Governor' and 'Other' roles have their own Launch Pads which can now be managed by clicking **Edit Grid** and selecting them from the list on the left hand side.

In the RM Unify App Library any Apps which are compatible with these roles can now be added to the 'Governor' and 'Other' Launch Pads by selecting the relevant **Check Boxes**.

**Note that with this release only 'Link based Apps' (which do not have Single Sign On) will support the 'Governor' and 'Other' roles.** We have plans to expand this as these individual Apps begin to support this functionality, but in the meantime these roles will be **Greyed Out** within the RM Unify App Library. The Microsoft Office 365 and Google Apps for Education Apps will support these roles with the next release (RM Unify v1.26).
