

Terms & Conditions of RM Education’s Integris deal – Free Migration for Primary Schools (the “Offer”)

1. By requesting a booking in relation to the Offer, the educational establishment is deemed to have read, understood and accepted these terms and conditions and will therefore be legally bound by them.
